IMPORTANT EXPLANATORY NOTES FOR APPLICANTS

The 'Isle of Skye Ferry CIC' was registered in 2006 as a Community Interest Company. It does not have shares or shareholders, but instead it has members. Its unpaid directors, employees and other voluntary staff carry out the day-to-day management of the Company.

By paying the registration fee of £2 you will be considered for membership of the Company. You will be supporting the Company and helping to keep this historic community ferry service running. You will also be entitled to the following:

- to purchase of ferry tickets at discount prices
- to receive an occasional newsletter
- to vote at meetings
- to receive the Company's annual report and financial statement
- to nominate directors for election
- to vote on any proposed changes to the Company.

This application for membership of 'Isle of Skye Ferry CIC' contains a declaration (a legal requirement under the Companies Act) whereby you agree to pledge (not pay now) a sum not exceeding £1 in the unlikely event of the Company being wound up. It is important you sign this declaration, as only by doing so will you be legally entitled to the benefits described above and be able to vote as a member of the Company at any General or Annual General meeting.

If the Company makes a profit this will be retained to help pay for the Company's activities in the following years. If the Company is wound up you will not receive any money from the Company because its constitution requires that it should be paid to another similar community organisation determined by you, the members.

- You **will not** be personally liable for any debts of the company by becoming a member.
- You **will not** be personally liable if someone brings a legal case against the company.

This is because like most other companies it is a limited company, which means your liability as a member is limited. If the Company is ever wound up then you will have to pay **not more** than the **£1**, which you have pledged to it. This is the maximum amount that you 'guarantee' or promise to pay to the Company to help pay toward any outstanding debts.
